Raymund Königk is a lecturer in the Programme for Interior Architecture, Department of Architecture, University of Pretoria. His master's dissertation, entitled *Interior design as architecture's 'Other'*, investigated interior design as a discipline and defined it as a profession. The research contributed towards negotiations between the South African Council for the Architectural Profession (SACAP) and the IID. Raymund is a current member of the IID's Education Committee. His expertise on interior design as a profession is unique nationally and scarce globally.



As invited speaker and contracted researcher he has contributed to a number of national and international seminars and conferences, including a recent conference at Ball State University, Indiana. His theoretical expertise in interior design is highly respected and he has presented critical reviews for *Architecture South Africa* and contributed to the autobiography of Sir Terence Conran, amongst others. His published works include refereed articles, technical reports and other scholarly based contributions. Raymund has established and maintains numerous international academic contacts in the fields of housing and interior design, including in Brazil, the USA, Indonesia, Australia, and New Zealand.

Raymund has several years experience as an interior designer. He is the principal interior designer in a multi-disciplinary design and architecture consultancy. Raymund is the recipient of two professional awards and numerous academic prizes.

If Raymund is elected to the IID Council he intends to apply his expertise towards the ultimate aim of establishing interior design as a registered profession in South Africa. He is dedicated to developing the knowledge base and professionalism of interior design □
